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**SUBJECT:**

Consider approval of street closures for the Annual O'Odham Tash Parade to be held on Saturday, February 15, 2020.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends the Mayor and City Council authorize the street closures outlined in this document to support the Annual O'Odham Tash Parade to be held on Saturday, February 15, 2020.

**DISCUSSION:**

The parade will require temporary closure of Brown Avenue from Florence Blvd. to 5th Street for staging purposes. We also ask that portions of 4th, 3rd, 2nd, and Florence Streets be closed to vehicle traffic to accommodate the parade through the route. The attached map shows the parade route and staging area. This is the same staging and route that has been used in past years.

Florence Blvd. will also be temporarily closed to vehicle traffic so the parade may proceed from Brown Avenue onto Florence Street. The parade committee plans to notify the general public by news releases and social media attention of the event. The closures are as follows and all times are approximate;

Staging Area - Brown Avenue from 5th Street to Highway 84. 7:00am until end of parade (approximately 12:00 pm)

Parade Route - Florence Blvd., Florence St., 2nd, 3rd, 4th Streets. 8:15 am until the end of the parade (approximately 12:00 pm)

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Approval of this action will have a fiscal impact primarily for the Police Department and Public Works Department to coordinate street closures and insure safety and compliance. Community Services employees will also be working the parade.
