RECOMMENDATION:

If a grant is awarded by Gila River Indian Community, the Staff recommends Mayor and Council give authorization to accept grant funds, authorization to execute contract, authorization to accept and disburse funds, authorization for budget transfers.

DISCUSSION:

Under Proposition 202, Arizona Tribes agreed to share a portion of their revenues with the State of Arizona. Of the revenues shared, 12% is made available to cities, towns, or counties for the purpose of benefiting the general public through either direct distribution to the local governments or in the form of a deposit to the State of Arizona’s Commerce and Economic Development Commission’s Local Community Fund. As all applications to the tribes require a resolution of the City of Casa Grande if awarded, the City created a procedure to collect all Proposition 202 requests at the same time, review them to be sure they address tribal target areas and dollars are spent or benefit Casa Grande residents. This process is intended to consolidate the requests, review them together, and present to council as a consolidated packet.

The cover sheet of each grant submittal is included in the agenda and the entire application packet is available for review upon request.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The City of Casa Grande would be responsible for the pass through of these funds. We anticipate this would take approximately 10 hours of staff resources with an approximate cost of less than \$500.
