Included in the youth programs are the Lego Club, mentoring, recreation, crafts, and food preparation. The Lego Club will be meeting weekly in the mornings during summer breaks, and in the afternoons during school months. The children are not only taught how to construct an object made from Legos, but they also learn to communicate with others, and to work as a team. Educational mentoring, recreational activities, crafts, and food preparations are done while the after-school children meet at the Mondo Anaya Community Center both in the summer and during the school months. What a thrill it is to see our children become self-confident, inspired students!

The adult education programs include English as a Second Language and Jobs for Life. If you are even a little bit bilingual, you are what the English as a Second Language Program needs! This class is will be offered in the Fall and in the Spring. When you help a person speak English more affluently, you help them acquire employment, help them to communicate with their children's teachers more understandably, and you help them to communicate less stressfully in public places. Jobs for Life requires volunteers who are good communicators and listeners, patient, compassionate, and emotionally and spiritually mature. If that is you, then come join us as we give youth and adults the opportunity to know how to get a job and to keep it by being a responsible employee. The students are taught using biblically based concepts. When the students graduate, they are employable citizens capable of providing for their families, the businesses that hire them will have a well-trained workforce, and the volunteers will have used their personal passions and skills to impact the lives of people in their own community.

The Hot Lunch Program needs volunteers to help individuals and families with their immediate needs of food and clothing Monday through Saturday. We are also looking for people to give the half-hour devotional taken right out of the Daily Bread booklets.
